# Free On-Site Flu Vaccination Clinic

Administered by an Independent Community Pharmacist

**\*\*NOTE\*\*** Appointment times are arbitrary & only meant to reserve your dose **\*\*NOTE\*\***

Vaccines will be administered in the order patients arrive

***Appointments need to be booked in advance to reserve your dose (as supply is limited),  
and for administrative purposes only***

**\*\* If you have an appointment you may show up any time during clinic hours \*\***

**WALK-INS \*WITHOUT AN APPOINTMENT\* WILL BE ACCOMODATED IF SUPPLY ALLOWS**

- \* **Flu shots are free for all Nova Scotians**
- \* **The vaccine contains no living virus and therefore cannot cause the flu**
- \* **Influenza can increase your risk of pneumonia, heart disease related hospitalization, and stroke**
- \* **Every year in Canada it is estimated that 10-20% of the population will become infected leading to over 12 200 hospitalizations and 3500 deaths**
- \* **Getting vaccinated can help protect those around you from becoming sick**
- \* **It is recommend that recipients stay at the clinic site for 15 minutes post-vaccination to ensure no reaction occurs** (ex. Dizziness can occur after any injection)
- \* **Vaccination site is the Deltoid muscle (upper arm near shoulder), a sleeveless shirt is recommended for site access, or arm can be removed from a sleeved shirt**
