

Information for families that you may choose to use

Student safety is a priority for the Halifax Regional School Board and the Province of Nova Scotia. In order for the Halifax Regional School Board to comply with Nova Scotia Motor Vehicle Regulations, subsection 175(8), we must identify students who are under nine years of age who weigh less than 18kg (40lbs) and have a standing height of less than 145cm (4'9"). These children will be required to be secured in a child restraint system when traveling on a regular school bus.

We will be measuring and weighing all grade primary students with the clothing and footwear they have on regularly in the classroom in order to identify those students who do not meet the above weight and height limits. We will also weigh and measure any student in a higher grade who is under 9 years old and suspect may not meet the weight and height limits.
